1. **DEFINITION :**

- (iii) Office Bearers Means :- President, General Secretary, & Assistant Secretary & Treasurer.
- (iv) Financial Year means :- 1st April to 31st March.
- (v) General Body means :- Formed all type members of the Society
- (vi) Act & Rule Means :- Societies Registration Act 21 of 1860 and society Registration Rules 1965 of Bihar (Amended as Notification No. 726 Dated-18-11-2005 and affiliated by the State of Jharkhand)

2. **TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF MEMBERSHIP:**

Subject to his/her application being recommended by at least two members of the Governing Body, any person with appreciable technical knowledge and agreeing to the aims and objectives of the society and agreeing in writing to be bound by the Memorandum and Rules and Regulations of the society may become its members.

On Payment of Rs. 20,000/-

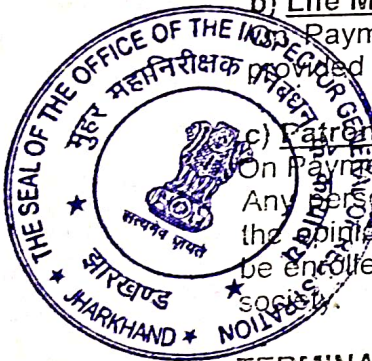

TERMINATION OF THE MEMBERSHIP :

Any Membership will be discontinued on :-

- Becoming insolvent or declared insane by a Court of Law.
- Being convicted by a Court of Law.
- Resignation by the Member.

- Non-Payment of the subscription or such other dues within the specified time.

4. **FORMATION OF GOVERNING BODY:**

- b) Shall maintain minutes books of all meetings and issue general circulars and notice.

- h) Shall do correspondence & agreement of government/ non-government/ private sectors.

D) Treasurer :

- a) Shall assist the General Secretary in maintaining the books of accounts and other financial rescores of the society.

E) Assistant Secretary :

- a) Assistant Secretary shall Assist the General Secretary.

Notice of every meeting starting the General Particulars of all matter to be transacted at such meeting shall be delivered or sent by post to each member.

(ii) Clear days notice specifying the place, date, time and nature of matter shall be given to the members by post or by hand delivery.

(iii) In case of emergent meeting the same can be convened by giving a notice of 24 hours only.

(iv) In the Interest of organisation General Secretary /Assistant Secretary has such power to debar any executive member or any another member for his/her post or duties.



10. **QUORUM:-**

50% + 1 members present and entitled to vote shall form a quorum at any meeting. If at one extraordinary meeting there is no quorum within half an hour the meeting shall stand dissolved. If at any annual general body meeting there is no quorum within half for the time fixed the meeting shall be adjourned and no quorum will be necessary for and adjourned meeting.

15. INSPECTION OF REGISTER :

All records will be kept in registered office of the society, any member with to inspect can do so with the prior permission of the General Secretary.

16. LEGAL PROCEEDING :

The secretary of the Society shall represent all the legal proceedings by or against society. All documents executed by or infavour of the society shall be in the General Secretary/President/Vice-President of the Society.

17. DISSOLUTION OF THE SOCIETY :

a) Before dissolution of the society, society will take permission from State Government under section of society Registration Act 21, 1860.

b) The society shall he dissolved at any special meeting of the general body convened for the purpose when three-fifth of the members vote for such resolution.

c) On dissolution of the society being decided open in accordance with the provision of section 14, any property, whatsoever, distributed amongst the members of one society but shall be made over to some other society or societies with similar objects or to the government to be determined by the vote of not less then Three-fifth of the members at the time of dissolution.

18. ASSETS AND Liabilities DURING REGISTRATION PERIOD OF BIHAR :
